## Facilities

The ***Old Boarding House*** is a renovated Victorian building offering traditional shared boarding rooms. ***Whitbarrow Hall*** provides modern, individual, en-suite accommodation. Everyone can socialise together in the various common rooms, dining room and acres of outdoor space surrounding the site.

Boarders have great facilities to keep them entertained and physically fit – basketball courts, table tennis, pool table, volleyball nets, televisions and gaming consoles, as well as common room areas to just socialise. An obvious benefit of boarding is that there are always friends around to do things with, be it having a chat or an impromptu game of football.
