# Where can I find important information about my exam(s)?

- For external exams, candidates are provided with an individual timetable which will be handed to you in form time/exam assembly.

## What should I wear?

- Full uniform including blazer.
- For Winter exams, if you are concerned you are going to be cold then wear a vest under your shirt, or a school cardigan.

## What shouldn't I wear?

- Coats are not permitted in the Exam Room.
- Normal school uniform rules apply, e.g., skirt should not be rolled up, no hats or hoodies.
- No air pods/ear phones/ear buds.
- No watches or technology of any sort (e.g. smart watches).
- No phone in trouser pocket or inside skirt waistband or pocket no mobile phones are allowed in the Exam Room.

## What items should I have with me?

- Items listed on the 'Preparing to sit your Exams Checklist' see the Exams section of our school website in a clear pencil case or clear plastic bag.
- You are allowed to bring a bottle of water in a <u>clear</u> (not tinted) container with no labels or writing on. No food permitted.

## What might I be asked to do prior to entering the Exam Room?

- Hold back your hair to check for ear buds.
- Pull back long sleeve cuffs to check for watches.
- Wash off any writing or doodling on hands/body.
- Remove calculator covers.
- Empty pockets to check for any paper/notes.

### Where can I leave my belongings?

• Coats, bags, phones and unpermitted items will be left in the Waiting Area.

### When do 'exam conditions' start?

- As soon as you enter the Exam Room.
- Line up outside the Exam Room, no talking, enter Exam Room when invited by invigilator, find your seat.
- The invigilator will read out an announcement to remind you of the rules and to carry out final checks.
- Put your hand up if you have any questions.
- Do <u>not</u> start filling in your details on the front of your exam paper the invigilator will instruct when to do this, and will tell you when to start.

#### What happens when the exam finishes?

- The invigilator will tell you when to stop writing.
- If you finish early you wait quietly in your seat until the exam has finished. You do not leave the room until the papers have been collected in during this time you must not talk.
- After leaving the Exam Room you return to the Waiting Area to collect your belongings. A member of staff will inform you when transport has arrived to take you back to Milnthorpe.

### If you have an afternoon exam as well ...

- Bring your own packed lunch to eat in the Waiting Area.
- You can bring revision notes for the afternoon exam (but cannot take into the exam).
- Bring relaxing music to listen to, or a book to read.
