The key to being a successful language learner is to practise little and often. Start doing these things today to ensure you get the grade you want at the end of your GCSE.

- **Practise vocabulary:** use the vocab sheets you have been given from the textbook, start making vocabulary flashcards or practise online using Memrise, Quizlet, duolingo or Kahoot. It doesn't matter which method you decide to use, just start doing it now! It is impossible to cram for a language exam. Aim to do 10 minutes of vocabulary at least 2 or 3 times a week to ensure you are confident for the exam.
- **Grammar:** learn your verb endings. Test yourself weekly. Again you could make flashcards or go online (www.languagesonline.com) to practise. Grammar is key to being able to communicate in the Writing & Speaking exams.
- **Make revision notes:** as you revise each unit, make a mind map of language and phrases you could use in your Writing & Speaking exams.
- **Use your French:** read newspapers, magazines or blogs online. Listen to French music. Watch French films. Speak French at home to your family even if they don't understand. You can only get better at a language by practising it!
