

Learning goes way beyond the classroom, young people are always learning. From the moment they wake, to the moment their eyes close again at bedtime, children are learning.



Welcome to our student community

Young people from around the world board at Dallam for short experience courses or full-time studies. Living at the school's Heversham site, they learn alongside 1,000 state pupils, aged between 11 and 19 years old. Boarders bring a unique dimension to school life, making it a great place to learn for everyone. Ofsted boarding inspectors were impressed by the sense of friendship, community and respect between boarders that they found here.

English countryside

Set in the beautiful English countryside in the north of England, pupils experience busy village life in and around the two historic centres of Heversham and Milnthorpe. With its medieval heritage, Milnthorpe is also very modern with lots of shops, cafés, takeaways, and friendly local people. It's a good contrast to the quieter and older village of Heversham where you'll find the boarding house.

Flexible boarding

We offer lots of different boarding options. Some students come for a short-stay immersion to boost English language skills, while others join us for more traditional weekly, full-time options to gain educational qualifications. There are also flexible, two to five-night boarding tasters, which are a good way to see if it works for your family. All of our boarding choices deliver on safety and care, personal development and friendships, and new cultures, languages, and experiences.

State boarding

Dallam is one of the UK's select few state boarding schools. We offer students a full and exciting school life, including high-quality English language education, at a significantly lower cost than independent boarding schools.

Well connected

Milnthorpe and Heversham have great connections to the rest of the country. By road you are soon on the M6 motorway, with the Scottish and Yorkshire borders close by. Trains from Oxenholme Lake District, Carnforth and Arnside get students to UK cities like London, Edinburgh and Glasgow in under 3 hours. The nearest international airports are Manchester and Liverpool, followed by Glasgow. There are ferry links at Heysham for the Isle Of Man too.


Famous Lakes

Just 20 minutes by car, it's a place that's as important to humanity as the likes of the Taj Mahal and the Grand Canyon. Boarders get lots of opportunities to explore this extraordinary landscape and all that it offers - from active adventure to artistic inspiration.



An English school with 17th century roots

Dallam School was founded in 1984 through the merger of the very old Heversham Grammar School and the newer Milnthorpe Secondary School. The Grammar School was founded in 1613 by Edward Wilson. His descendants still live at Dallam Tower, a large 18th century country estate on the outskirts of Milnthorpe. They are involved in the running of the school today. From its earliest years the school catered for boarders, whose homes were too far away for them to be day pupils, and it was linked through the church community to the University of Cambridge.

The top cities of London, Edinburgh and Glasgow can be reached by train in under 3 hours. Which means it's possible to take in some of their cultural and historical delights in a day.




Lake District

Boarding options at Dallam

Dallam School has a flexible approach to parental and pupil needs.

We offer full time boarding, weekly boarding, flexi-boarding and short-stay immersion programmes:

Full time boarding

Your child lives in the boarding house full time, during term time and returns home or to stay with a guardian during the holidays.

Weekly boarding

Your child commits to boarding Sunday-Friday every week, during term time and returns home for the weekend.

Flexi-boarding

Pupils can stay for 2-5 nights on a flexible arrangement, by prior arrangement.

Short stay immersion

International pupils can stay from 4-12 weeks on a short-stay arrangement, to improve English language and to gain cultural knowledge.

Boarding life

Our younger boarders (years 7-11), typically live in bedrooms with 2-3 peers of a similar age which allows them to mature and develop socially. Where possible, we place boarders of similar backgrounds and interests together during the first term to help them settle in. At Dallam School, friendships are formed that will last a lifetime.

Our Sixth Form pupils live in Whitbarrow Hall. All rooms are single occupancy, ensuite rooms which helps to prepare our Sixth Formers with the independence and space they need as they embark on their A-Level courses.

There are a range of supervised activities provided for boarders every evening, including sport, time to contact home, and creative activities. Our boarders also look forward to our weekly excursions at the weekends.

All of our boarding pupils quickly form an integral part of the Dallam School community, enriching the whole school with their multiple languages, cultures and wider knowledge of the world.

Teaching facilities at Dallam

Dallam School is made up of three modern school campuses. The main school site is in Milnthorpe, with our boarding site and the sports site, Tristrams Playing Fields, in Heversham. Teaching facilities include tech rooms, science labs, art rooms, drama studio and the library.









Sport at Dallam

Sport at Dallam is available on many levels. As a social activity, right through to playing a team sport or competing as an individual at county and national level. Great all-year-round facilities include two sports halls at the Milnthorpe site, plus fitness suite and Astroturf and multiple pitches – all used by local community, dance groups and local football teams.

Add to that a further sports hall at Heversham, plus all-weather tennis courts, and cricket and rugby pitches at Tristrams. Whether winning, losing or drawing, there's lots to be proud of, and lots of sports to get involved with here at Dallam.









Sporting talent

Past and present pupils include an exciting wave of British runners making a name for themselves on the international cross-country scene. And there are others earning titles like English Fell Running Champion. Given all the countryside and hills that surround us, there's always an invitation to get out in the fresh air on a run.

Seasonal Sports

Each term brings a different sporting focus, In the summer, its cricket, rounders and athletics. You'll see us take part in the South Lakes Schools District Athletics Trials and there are after school yoga and running clubs. In the autumn and winter you'll find us hosting outdoor football and hockey matches against fellow South Lakes Federation schools alongside netball matches in the sports hall.

Duke of Edinburgh

For the last 30 years we've encouraged and supported our students to complete the Duke of Edinburgh Award. It's great for developing confidence, independence, problem-solving skills and provides a sense of achievement whilst improving fitness and health. It's also a great way to explore the brilliant coast and mountains on our doorstep.

Extra awards

We hold the Youth Sport Trust Quality Mark – Bronze level. The award highlights the strength and quality of the work our team does in delivering both curricular and extra-curricular sport. It also demonstrates the value the school places on its provision and commitment to providing a high-quality physical education, school sport and physical activity offer for all our students.

Dallam Experience

A short stay immersive programme where international students aged 11-19 are placed in classes of native English speakers. During the week they will:

- Follow a full timetable of subjects alongside English speaking students of a similar age
- Have comfortable full board boarding accommodation
- Study additional EAL as required (not included in price)
- Join weekly excursions
- Join supervised afterschool activities
- Have 24/7 residential pastoral care

School to home communication

We use 'School Synergy' to communicate between school, pupils, guardians and parents. It's a great way to quickly access information such as attendance, behaviour, timetables and homework. We also run our home-school messaging, calendar, and parents' evenings through the system. All the important information that a parent or pupil might need is just a few clicks away using a computer, tablet or mobile.
