

# Welcome to Heversham

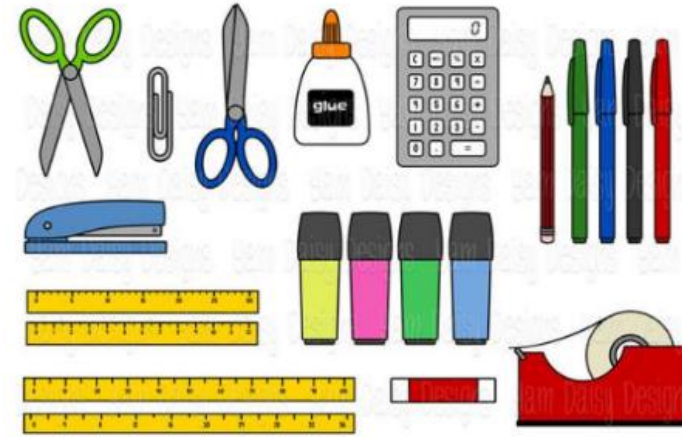
## Year 11 + 13 Examinations





**Equipment:** Students are responsible for bringing their own equipment and we cannot guarantee that there will be equipment to borrow. Equipment should be placed in a clear plastic pencil case or clear plastic bag (tinted, or mesh, or semi-see through is not allowed):

- 2 black pens
- 1 HB pencil
- ruler (marked with cm/mm)
- pencil sharpener
- eraser
- calculator (specific subjects) – students need to know how to clear the memory and remove the cover whilst in the exam room



Certain exams will require: compass, protractor, coloured pencil crayons, authorised texts.

Do not bring correction fluid, glue sticks or any other equipment that is not on this list – these items are classed as non-permitted and if found in the exam room would be reported.

## In the Exam Room

- Students must not enter the exam room until told to do so by the invigilator.
- Silence is required as soon as students enter the exam room, whilst they are there and whilst they leave.
- Exam conditions start as soon as they enter the room; find their seat and wait for further instructions.
- Students that require assistance, must put their hand up and wait for an invigilator. They must not turn around or have any contact (including eye contact) with another student.
- Invigilators will start and finish the exam. They must collect all exam papers in before students leave the room.
- Students must remain in their seats until they are permitted to leave.
- Follow invigilator instructions at all times.

**Food/drink** is not allowed in the exam room except water in a clear (non-coloured) plastic bottle with no markings, labels or logos whatsoever.

**Mobile phones and watches:** Mobile phones and watches should not be brought into the exam rooms. If a mobile phone, watch or electrical device is found in your possession during an exam, even if turned off, the device will be confiscated and a malpractice report made to the exam board. Students are at risk of disqualification.

## Exam days at Heversham

- Students must attend in full school uniform.
- The school behaviour policy will still apply.
- Students should bring their exam timetable with them, showing the exam room, time and seat number.
- Upon arrival at Heversham, students should wait quietly by the entrance gate to be let in by a member of staff. Any student not wearing uniform, will be required to wait for a member of the Senior Team to sign them in.
- All students should proceed to the Lecture Theatre quietly and wait there until they are called for their exam. Please remember that it is possible that exams will already have started or be continuing when students arrive so please remind your son/daughter to respect candidates working close by and wait quietly both in the Lecture Theatre and adjacent toilet areas, and when on their way to and from the exam room.
- There are no catering facilities at Heversham. Your son/daughter has exams in both the morning and afternoon and they will need to bring lunch and a drink with them.
- Items that are not allowed in the exam room, e.g. bags, phones, coats, ear buds, etc must be left in the Lecture Theatre.

## Examination Information and absence

- Students must attend all examinations on their timetables
- Morning exams start at 9am or shortly there after
- Afternoon exams start at 1pm or shortly there after
- There is a 30minute allowance in which a student can attend late to the exam
- Illness or medical emergency must be certified by a doctor, physician or consultant  
Students must sit one element worth at least 20% of the course to certificate
